

Phoebe Griswold to Speak at Grace Church Wednesday - November 30

Phoebe Griswold, a dynamic advocate for the global mission of the Episcopal Church and wife of the Most Rev. Frank T. Griswold, Presiding Bishop of the Episcopal Church, USA, will visit Charleston on Wednesday November 30.

At 6:45pm Wednesday evening she will be the featured speaker at Grace Church Charleston. Her presentation about worldwide connections in the Anglican Communion promises to be a positive, uplifting story of the ministry of the whole church. The program is open to the public; all are welcome.

Earlier that day Mrs. Griswold will meet with members of the local chapter of the "Society of The Companions of The Holy Cross" (SCHC) of which she is an active member.

Phoebe Griswold said in an address earlier this year "we as members of the Episcopal Church are part of a global community

because we are a member of the worldwide Anglican Communion and that our Episcopal Church Offices at 815 Second Avenue offer us many bridges to the wider world for the work of transformation and reconciliation This work of transformation and reconciliation is the missio Dei, God's mission, in which we are privileged to participate. Our church is already part of a global world view. This identity requires us to envision authentic Christian values and practices wherever we are or are called to be in our world. Where globalization builds community and promotes sharing of resources, the church may cooperate. Where globalization dehumanizes persons and erodes vital community, the church is called to resist and to insist on Christ's promise of a more abundant live.
